Selection Process:

A representative from the RCC Foundation will review submitted applications and forward approved applications for recommendation to award by appropriate faculty members and the ECE Department Head. Scholarship awards will be based on the following:

- Submission of a completed application form, including essay and intake form.
- Current enrollment in courses for which funding is requested.
- An achievable education plan and likelihood of completing the plan.
- Agreement to complete a Follow-up Survey from the RCC Foundation for five years after program completion (this is for statistical reporting purposes only).

Awarding Funds:

Successful candidates will be selected and awarded funds to cover tuition and fees only; the awards will be placed directly into RCC student accounts. The maximum scholarship awarded is \$500 per term.

Continuing Eligibility:

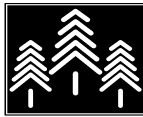
Recipients may re-apply each term. Scholarship recipients will be tracked by the RCC Foundation and must maintain satisfactory academic progress to maintain their scholarship eligibility (completion of all courses covered by Gray funding and a minimum 2.50 GPA).
